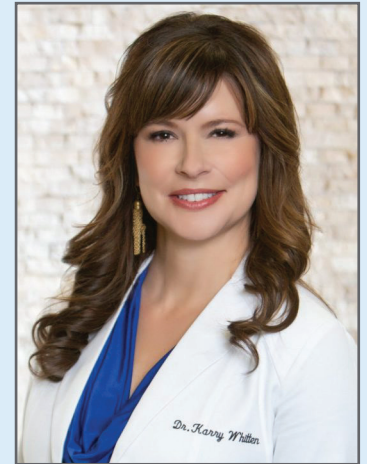
## Course Information
