Friday, June 7, 2024

The Nebraska Academy of General Dentistry will hold its Annual Meeting on Friday, June 7, 2024. We are very excited to bring in speaker, Dr. Mike Melkers. The title of his lecture is “Lemons to Lemonade—Achieving Aesthetics in a World of Challenges”.

The Nebraska Academy of General Dentistry is devoted to advancing excellence in general dentistry through excellent continuing education programs. Speaker: Dr. Michael Melkers

Dr. Melkers is in private practice in Hanover, NH but impacts students, clinicians and patients worldwide Dr. Melkers is a 1994 graduate of Marquette University School of Dentistry & currently serves as Visiting Faculty at Rīga Stradiņš University in Riga, Latvia & as Advisor and Visiting Faculty for The Pankey Institute in Key Biscayne, Florida. Dr. Melkers is a Fellow & Master of the Academy of General Dentistry and holds additional Fellowships in the International Congress of Oral Implantologists and the American College of Dentists. He maintains a private clinical practice in Hanover, NH with a focus on comprehensive adult restorative care. Dr. Melkers balances his professional time between clinical practice, teaching, publishing and research. In the past, he has been Director of Occlusion & Aesthetic Dentistry at the Pacific Northwest AEGD Residency Program and Visiting Faculty at The Spear Institute. He completed his tenure as Editor for the American Equilibration Society and received the 2018 AES President's Distinguished Service Award for his service. He has been involved with the Academy of General Dentistry at a local, state and national level for his entire career Dr. Melkers current passion is serving as the Director for Educator Development for RIPEGlobal, as well as the Co-Director for their Fellowship in Restorative dentistry. His mission is to help students, teams and clinicians realize what is possible and improve the level of patient care, worldwide.

HANDS-ON TRAINING

Building on Day One, participants will experience the nuances of shape, color and contour. Together we will explore how modifications of each can help us achieve successful outcomes through a sea of challenges.

- Know how to correct over-bulked and misshaped restorations
- Be able to fabricate provisional matrices and shell provisionals
- Stain and characterize provisional restorations

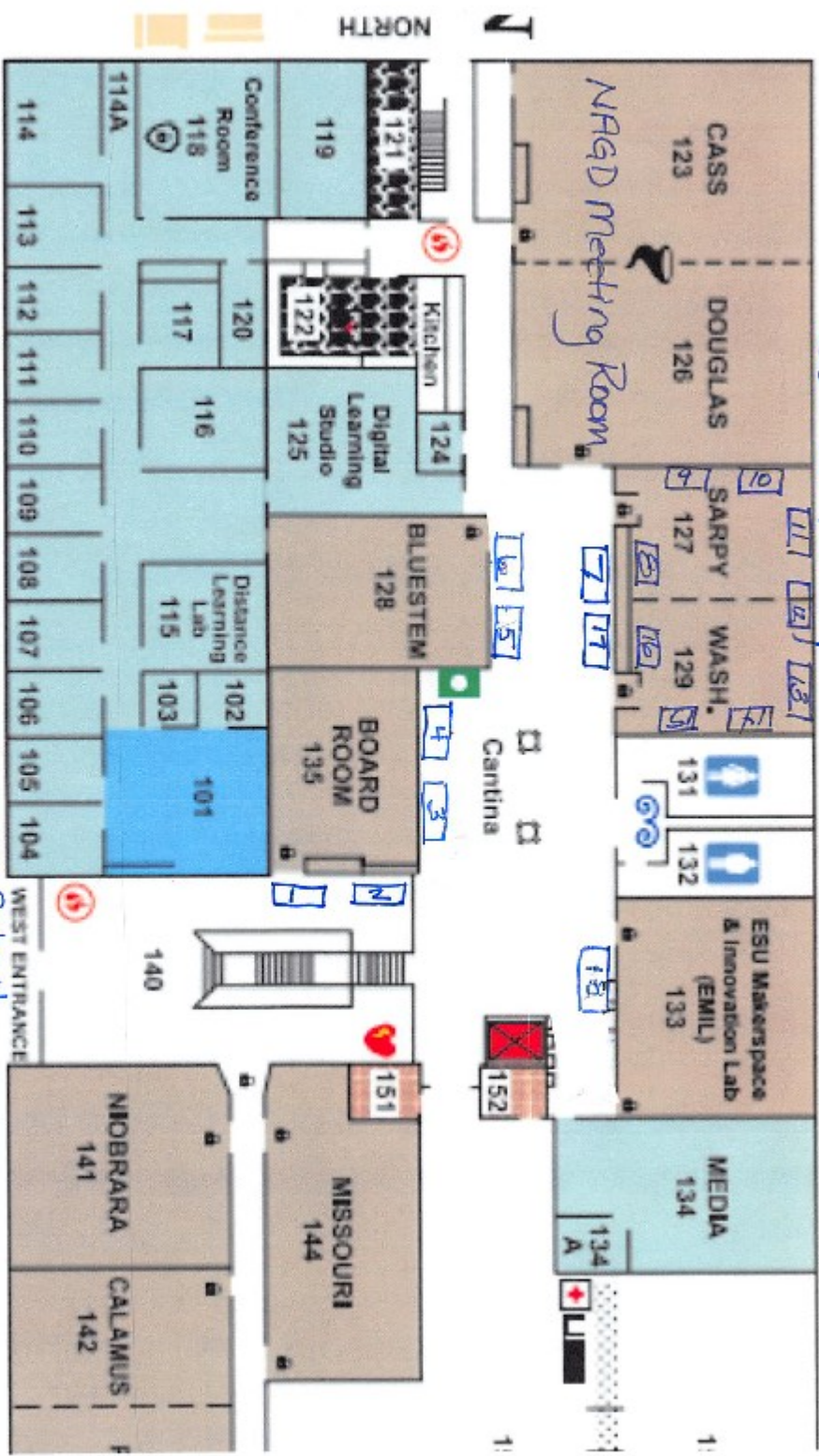
